In the event of a discrepancy between the software and advance materials (e.g., a printed catalog), the item description on the software is correct. If you have questions about any of the items, please ask a silent auction volunteer.

Placing a Bid:

- When placing a bid, bidder should enter the maximum bid amount they are willing to pay. The system will automatically increase the bid to that amount each time another bidder outbids the bid. An outbid notice will be sent via text to the registered cell providing the opportunity to increase the bid.
- 2. Each bidder will need to enter a credit card upon placing their first bid. Please note that no hold will be placed on the card, the card will only have to be entered once, and the card will not be charged unless the bidder wins the item. The auction software is a secure site with a safety certificate.
- 3. Only the registered credit card may be used for payment of auction items, and the balance cannot be divided between more than one credit card.
- 4. Please ensure that the card registered has a credit limit high enough to cover the auction items being bid on.
- 5. Should assistance be needed placing a bid, bidding kiosks will be available at the silent auction desk and throughout the meeting space. NAPA's registration desk staff or associate members staffing the silent auction desk will be able to provide help placing bids or registering.
- 6. NAPAREF reserves the right to withdraw any item without notice.
- 7. NAPAREF highly suggests that bidders bidding on a high-priced item call their credit card company and provide notice that they may have a large charge in California.

Close of Bidding:

1. Bidding will end at 9:00 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 9. However, if there is a last-minute bid on an item, bidding will remain open for just those items until there has been no bidding activity for 10 minutes.

Payment for Items Won:

- After winning, an email notification will be sent advising of items won and the winning bid amount. The credit card that was entered upon registration for the auction will be **automatically charged** for the winning bid amount, plus 8% CA sales tax, if applicable for that item. A receipt will be sent to the registered email address stating that the item has been paid for.
- 2. Should the credit card be declined, a notification will be sent to the registered email. Winners should pay close attention to their email to ensure that the credit card was successfully charged. If the card is declined, bidder must go to the silent auction desk to provide an alternate payment method within 30 minutes or the prize will be assigned to the next highest bidder.
- 3. Winning bidder is solely responsible for the shipping of the item, including the packaging.
- 4. Winning bidder is responsible for sales tax for certain items. If CA sales tax is to be collected on an item, the item's description will state that.

Pickup of Items:

- Pickup of items will be outside of the Young Leaders Dinner from 9:00 p.m.—11:00 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 9. All items must be picked up, a receipt signed indicating that the item has been picked up, and paid for by 11:00 p.m. Items will not be available for pickup on Wednesday, Feb. 10.
- Item must be picked up by the actual winner by 11:00 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 9. A photo I.D. will be required to pick up all items. Any item left unclaimed at 11:00 p.m. will be forfeited and proceeds will go to NAPA Care.
- 3. All sales are final, and there will be no exchange, substitution, or refund on items.
- 4. Winning bidder **must be present** at the auction's end to win the item.
- 5. Reservations for trips, stays in hotels, use of facilities, ticket redemption (or other applicable items or actions) must be mutually arranged by the winning bidder and the donor within thirty (30) days of auction night. NAPAREF has no role or responsibility in this regard, and there can be no recourse against NAPAREF. All trips and gift certificates must be redeemed by Dec. 31, 2016, unless otherwise indicated in the item's description. NAPAREF cannot be held responsible for gift certificates that lapse.
