## NAPA Summary H.R. 2471, Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022

- The agreement, introduced March 9, 2022, totals \$1.5 trillion in new funding for Federal domestic and defense programs.
- The bill <u>fully funds</u> the obligation limitation on contract authority for highway and airport programs authorized by the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA).
- State Departments of Transportation will be able to <u>fully utilize</u> their contract authority provided by IIJA in 2022.
- The bill <u>does not</u> include any fixes for authorized portions of IIJA. Thus, the Wicker-Stabenow amendment to make "paving activities" eligible under the Carbon Emissions Program will have to wait for a separate technical corrections bill prepared by the authorization committees.
- There are \$1.5 billion in earmarks, of which \$847 million are highway earmarks and \$280 million are Airport Improvement Program earmarks.
- NAPA secured \$3 million for the Asphalt Airfield Pavement Technology Program. NAPA has secured \$9 million in total for this program since 2020.
- There are no pavement mandates.
