

How to Determine Estimated Federal-Aid Highway Funding Apportionment for Your State Under IIJA

- Determine Baseline Funding for 2022 – 2026
 - “Apportioned Total” from Table #1 times 5 years = IIJA Baseline
 - Example: Alabama
 - $\$830,548,801 \times 5 = \$4,152,744,005$
 - **Baseline funding for Alabama over the next five years is $\$4,152,744,005$.**
- Determine Estimated Funding in IIJA
 - “Apportioned Total” from Table #2 = IIJA Funding
 - Example: Alabama
 - **Apportioned total for Alabama over the next five years is $\$5,535,664,910$.**
- Determine percent change in state highway funding apportionment
 - Increase = new number minus original number
 - Then: divide the increase by the original number and multiply the answer by 100
 - % increase = Increase \div original Number \times 100
 - Example: Alabama
 - $\$5,535,644,910 - \$4,152,744,005 = \$1,077,837,230 / \$4,152,744,005 = 0.2595 \times 100 = 25.95\%$
 - **Alabama’s increase in Federal Aid Highway funding under the formula over the next 5 years is $\$1,077,837,230$ or 33%.**
